

Viewing and Printing the Rising Cougar Proposed Treatment Area Map

The Rising Cougar Proposed Treatment Map included in this document as page two is derived from a 36 inch by 34 inch display map. It preserves a high degree of detail. This detail may not be evident when you initially view the map. However, by using the Zoom In, Zoom Out, and Pan tools in Adobe Reader you can view the map in greater detail.


The Zoom In and Zoom Out tools resemble a magnifying glass with either a plus sign (+) for the zoom in



function or a minus sign (-) for the zoom out function.

The Pan tool, which resembles a small hand,  allows one to drag the map up, down, right, or left.


When printing the map, keep in mind that it originates as a 34 inch by 36 inch map. To print the map on a single 8 ½ inch by 11 inch sheet be sure to check or select “Fit to page” or “Fit to paper” in your print dialog box. A sample print dialog box with the “Fit to paper” setting selected is shown below. The print dialog box on your PC may differ.
