A. Alternative Travel Area Goals, Objectives, Standards and Guidelines

Travel Planning Area Direction Under Alternative 1

Alternative 1 is the “no action” alternative. There would be no changes to current Forest Plan management direction applicable to travel management.

Travel Planning Area Direction Under Alternatives 2 through 7

GOAL 1: Summer Recreation Use. Provide opportunities for both motorized and non-motorized summer recreation use with emphasis on family-oriented hiking, biking and pleasure driving. *This goal is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 5, and 7. Alternative 6 would not provide much opportunity for motorized recreation in favor of reducing open motorized route density.*

OBJ. 1(1): Manage the road and trail system to provide for the following types of summer recreation use. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7, however the amount of opportunity varies between alternatives as shown in the following table.*

OBJ. 1(2): Provide a system of 2 to 6 mountain bike loop trails linking Hyalite Canyon to the Bozeman Creek and Cottonwood Creek drainages. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

OBJ. 1(3)a: Provide a paved trail from the mouth of the canyon to the reservoir to accommodate biking, roller-blading, etc. and remove the non-motorized traffic from Hyalite Road. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 3 and 4. This objective is not included in Alternative 2 because this alternative is designed to be similar to the no action alternative and there would be little investment in new trails. Alternatives 5 and 6 exclude the idea of a new trail in favor of maintaining better riparian habitat on the west side of Hyalite Creek.*

OBJ. 1(3)b: Widen the Hyalite Road from the mouth of the canyon to the reservoir to accommodate biking, roller-blading, etc. *This objective is applicable to Alternative 7.*

GOAL 2: Winter Recreation Use. Provide for a variety of winter recreation opportunities with an emphasis on family-oriented cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. *This goal is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

OBJ. 2(1): Manage the road and trail system to provide for the following types of winter recreation use. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 2*

through 7, however the amount of opportunity varies between alternatives as shown in the following table.

OBJ. 2(2): Improve winter passenger vehicle access to the canyon for family non-motorized recreation use. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

STANDARD 2(3): Use of sand or salt (NaCl) on the Hyalite Road is to be prohibited. *This standard is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

OBJ. 2(4): Provide loop trails for family-oriented day-use skiing. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

OBJ. 2(5): Provide ski trail connectors to the Bozeman Creek and Cottonwood Creek drainages for more advanced skiers. *This objective is applicable to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

GOAL 3: Fisheries. Provide habitat for westslope cutthroat trout in Wildhorse Creek. *This goal applies to Alternatives 2 through 7.*

In this Travel Planning Area, this goal is pursued through application of Forest-wide standards.
