

Attachment– South Belts Travel Plan Proposed Action

BACKGROUND

The initial proposed action for the South Belts that was developed in 2000 and has been modified based on public comments received during the scoping that was conducted in the fall of 2000, and based on the information provided in the narrative portion of the scoping document. These comments have been retained on file.

INTRODUCTION

We are defining roads as routes that are available to motorized vehicles consistent with State laws, motorized trails as routes that are available for vehicles 50 inches or less in width and non-motorized trails as unavailable for motorized users.

A feature common to all routes restricted seasonally or yearlong is that some kind of barrier such as a gate will be installed to ensure compliance.

This proposed action does not incorporate the temporary emergency closures that were developed in response to the Maudlow-Toston fire. The road closures incorporated in the Maudlow-Toston Salvage Timber Sale Record of Decision *are* included as part of the existing condition. This proposed action does not include any changes during the winter use period (12/2-5/15). The South Belts Winter Travel Plan Decision Notice (1999) made the decisions for this area for the winter period.

The following is a summary table of the miles of roads and trails (routes) available in the proposed action as compared to the existing condition for the routes in the South Belts and the primary reason for a change from the existing condition.

Roads and Trails of the South Belts and Their Proposed Availability

The individual routes in the proposed action are identified below. They are divided into two geographic areas to make it easier to find the routes that you are interested in: **Roads and Trails North of Deep Creek U.S. Highway 12 , and Roads and Trails South of Deep Creek U.S. Highway 12.** Each table lists the following: Road or trail name and number, proposed action, reason for the proposed action, existing condition and a column for your comments if you prefer to note them there. The proposed action and existing condition columns identify the dates showing when the route is available or restricted to motorized vehicles. Routes restricted yearlong to motorized vehicles are identified as such.

Trails identified as non-motorized are found in separate tables, Tables 2 and 4, and are available to persons on foot, horseback or other non-motorized method of travel. All motorized use is not permitted within the proposed Mt. Baldy proposed wilderness area and Camas Creek roadless area.

For ease of display, some routes are shown on the map crossing private property where there is currently no easement for public access. This issue will be addressed in the analysis.
