LOCATION AND ACCESS

From Mesa, take U.S. 60 to Idaho Exit #196. Go north on Hwy. 88. The entire route is paved but is narrow, has sharp curves and often has heavy traffic.

Canyon Lake Marina: Full-service marina, ice, water, snacks, restaurant, telephone, bait and tackle

CONSIDERATIONS

- On most weekends and holidays, April - October, Canyon Lake reaches its maximum boating capacity early in the day and no additional boats are allowed in.
- * On weekends and holidays, parking is for vehicles with boat-trailers only
- Be prepared for delays in boat access during summer weekends. Many of the Valley's radio stations carry advisories concerning crowding conditions.
- Arrange for boat sanitation pump out at Canyon Lake Marina (602) 944-6504
- **If you PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- Alternate boat launch: Palo Verde Boating Site, Canyon Lake Marina
- Glass containers are **not permitted**
