

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is 21 miles east of Carefree. From Carefree, take Cave Creek Road 7 miles to the junction with Forest Road (FR) 205. Turn right and travel 6 miles to the junction of FR 205 and FR 19. FR 19 to Bartlett Reservoir starts at this junction and is paved to the reservoir. Follow FR 19 for 7 miles to FR 459 and turn left. Travel ½ mile on FR 459 and turn right into the site.

ATTRACTIONS

- Rattlesnake Cove provides direct access to Bartlett Reservoir.
- Rattlesnake Cove has a sloping beach suitable for use in many water recreation activities.
- This area boasts of beautiful vistas of the desert with mountains in the background.

\$2.00 per watercraft per day
