

### SEASON OF USE

April - November

### ELEVATION

5250 feet

### FACILITIES

Vault toilets

**No drinking water** available

### BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

One vault toilet is equipped with grab bars; it may require some assistance.

### LOCATION AND ACCESS

**Access #1** (32 miles east of Payson): From Payson, travel east for 24 miles on State Hwy. 260. Turn right on unpaved Forest Road (FR) 291 and travel 3 miles to FR 200, (unpaved); turn right. Travel on FR 200 for 5 miles to the site.

**Access #2** (12 miles north of Young): From Young, travel 3 miles north on State Hwy. 288/Forest Road (FR) 512 to FR 200. Turn left on FR 200 and travel for 9 miles to the site.

### ATTRACTIONS

- This campground of dispersed units is situated along Haigler Creek.
- This campground boasts a diversity of tree varieties.
- Fishing for rainbow trout is a popular pastime here.
- The stream is periodically stocked with trout April-late August.
- The chiseled canyons offer swimming holes
- The campground serves as a trail termini for a 6-mile equestrian loop trail.

### FEES

None

### CONSIDERATIONS

- Not recommended for trailers **over 16 feet**
- Bear-proof your camp--especially foodstuffs
- A sewage dump facility is located at Ponderosa Campground on Highway 260, which is 15 miles east of Payson. There is a fee of \$5.00.
- No trash service: **PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- FR 200 and 291 are unpaved roads
- Four-wheel-drive or chains are advised after heavy rains or snow.
