

SEASON OF USE

April - November

ELEVATION

5200 feet

FACILITIES

Vault toilets
Covered large food preparation table
Grills
Holds up to 150 people

BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

One vault toilet is equipped with grab bars; it may require some assistance.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

19 miles south of Young and 50 miles north of Globe, on State Hwy. 288 (unpaved) to Forest Road (FR) 247.

FEES

\$40.00 per night per group

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED

- Call or write the Pleasant Valley Ranger Station: they start taking reservations the first working day after the New Year.
- Checkout time: 11:00 am

ATTRACTIONS

- This site is set along the perennial Reynolds Creek.
- A variety of vegetation is supported by Reynolds Creek. This allows your group to enjoy the grassy open spaces or the inviting shade of sycamore and ponderosa pine.
- Within walking distance of two exceptional wilderness areas: the Salome and the Sierra Ancha Wilderness.
- Reynolds Creek offers many diversions such as soaking in pools or enjoying the wildlife.

CONSIDERATIONS

- Restricted to **GROUPS ONLY**
- Not recommended for trailers or RVs **over 32 feet**.
- A sewage dump facility is located at Globe Chamber of Commerce Trailer Dump or at facilities located 7 miles west of State Hwy. 288 on State Hwy. 88. The facilities are on the north side of the road between the Grapevine and Schoolhouse Recreation sites (no fees).
- No trash service: **PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- In winter, temperatures dip into the teens.
