### RELATED OPPORTUNITIES

Boating, fishing, hiking, water recreation and wildlife-viewing

### SEASON OF USE

All year  
(Site closed when lake level drops below 2110 feet.)

### ELEVATION

2200 feet

### FACILITIES

54 camp units (single and double) with picnic tables and fire rings with grills. A paved boat launch ramp nearby is useable when the lake water elevation exceeds 2110 feet.

### BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

This site contains barrier-free camp units. Toilets, water hydrants and picnic tables are fully accessible.

### ATTRACTIONS

- Located on central Arizona's largest lake.
- Several miles of hiking and lake access trails wind through the site.
- This site offers a choice of single and double camp units, or shoreline use.

### FEES AND CAPACITIES

Day-use and camping fees apply.  
**Single site maximum:** (\$10.00 per night) 10 people, 2 vehicles and 1 watercraft.  
**Double site maximum:** (\$15.00 per night) 20 people, 4 vehicles and 2 watercraft.

### LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is approximately 13 miles northwest of Theodore Roosevelt Dam. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CROSS TONTO CREEK WHEN IT IS FLOWING!!**  
**From Mesa:** Take the State Hwy.87/Beeline Highway north for about 60 miles to the junction of State Hwy. 87 and State Hwy.188. Turn right and follow State Hwy.188 for 23 miles to its junction with Forest Road (FR) 60/A Cross. Turn left and continue across Tonto Creek for 2 miles to FR 661/Indian Point. Continue on FR 661 for one mile to the site. The entire route (except for the first ¾ mile of FR 60 where it crosses Tonto Creek) is paved.

**From the Globe area:** Take State Hwy.188 north for 30 miles to the junction of State Hwy.188 and State Hwy. 88. Continue on State Hwy.188 over the bridge for another 11 miles to Forest Road (FR) 60. Turn right onto FR 60 and continue to site as described above.

### CONSIDERATIONS

- Sewage dump facilities (no fee) are located 6 miles south of the State Hwy.188/FR 60 junction on State Hwy.188 at milepost 249, or 4 miles north of the State Hwy.188/FR 60 junction on State Hwy.188 at the Lazy JR trailer park (fee).
- Rules and regulations are posted at all fee station areas. Please read and observe.
- Please use trash receptacles, when available or **PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT!!**
- Camp host volunteers are usually available during the fall and winter months.
