

TRAILS
SALOME WILDERNESS

There is a network of “system” trails serving the Salome Wilderness Area and contiguous areas. Their condition varies from satisfactory to very poor. All trails are closed to motor vehicles and mechanical transport such as bikes.

Use a great deal of caution when traveling on backcountry trails such as this one and be aware of the risks you assume.

A few brief comments are in order about the following trail:

Pocket Trail 38: 7 miles in length. Most of this route is an old jeep trail, although it can be difficult to find and follow. Elevation: 3400 – 3797 feet. Termini: Forest Road 454 (near Pocket Cabin) and Forest Road 134 (northwest of Soldier Camp).

Use of any mechanized or motorized transportation is prohibited on this trail. No more than 15 people are allowed to be in a group. No more than 15 head of livestock are allowed in a group.
