RELATED OPPORTUNITIES

Tubing, picnicking, boating, fishing and hiking.

SEASON OF USE

All year
April 1 - October 31: day-use only
Winter camping: October 15 – March 15

ELEVATION

1400 feet

FACILITIES

Vault toilets
No drinking water available

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is 22 miles northeast of Mesa. From Mesa, travel 7 miles east on the Superstition Freeway/U.S. 60 to Power Road/Bush Highway/Forest Road (FR) 204 and turn north. Follow Bush Highway for 15 miles to the site. The entire route is paved.

ATTRACTIONS

Blue Point is a popular river-access point (RAP) for tubers floating the Lower Salt River

FEES

\$4.00 per vehicle (day-use)
\$6.00 camping fee during season only

CONSIDERATIONS

- This area becomes quite crowded on hot summer weekends
- Bring sun block and tennis shoes if planning to float the river
- To avoid injury, wear shoes when wading in the river
- Pets must be on a leash
- Jumping off bridges is prohibited
- No glass containers in the Lower Salt River area
- Please use trash receptacles
- CAUTION:** Fallen trees and other materials in the river can trap swimmers and floaters
- BEWARE!!** Alcohol, sun, and water are deadly combinations
