SPECIAL CLOSURE ORDER

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited in the area described in this order, and on National Forest System roads, and National Forest Development trails as described below, within the Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta National Forest until further notice.

1. Entering or being upon the road or trails described below which are closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR 261.54(a), 36 CFR 261.55(a)]
2. Entering or being upon the area described which is closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

**EXEMPTIONS:**

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

**CLOSURE DESCRIBED:**

This area is located in Utah County as shown on the attached map. The area lies within Township 9 South, Range 5 East, Sections 15, 22, 26, 27, 28, 34, 35 and 36, Salt Lake Meridian.

Trails included in the closure:  
Knoll Hollow (076)  
Teat Mountain (202)

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the closure is for public safety during helicopter mulching activities for the Red Bull Burned Area Emergency Rehabilitation project.

**EXHIBITS AND IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Exhibit 1, map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of above prohibited act is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
