FS Meetings Scheduled To Discuss OHV Grant Proposals

Placerville, CA... Two meetings are scheduled by the USDA Forest Service to review and discuss proposed Eldorado National Forest applications for 2004 – 2005 State of California off-highway vehicle management grants.

The first meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 23 from 7-9 PM in the large conference room in the Eldorado National Forest Supervisor's Office; 100 Forni Road, Placerville. A second meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 24 from 6 –8 PM in Jackson, California at the Best Western Express; 101 Clinton Road at Highway 49.

The Forest Service says the draft OHV grant applications focus on funding OHV law enforcement activities on four ENF ranger districts and winter law enforcement activities associated with over snow vehicle use – including OSV use around Desolation and Mokelumne Wilderness.

The preliminary law enforcement grant applications include funding for patrolling, posting signs, and installing various means of traffic control to prevent resource damage. In addition, grant funds are proposed to restore damaged resources in specific areas of the Eldorado National Forest.
