Snowshoe Walk On March 19th, Sign Up Early!

Soon winter will be giving way to spring, however, there are still plenty of opportunities to enjoy winter recreation. One way to enjoy the winter season is to snowshoe. The Lassen National Forest, Almanor Ranger District in Chester is sponsoring a free, public snowshoe walk Wednesday, March 19th, starting at 10:00 a.m. and ending around 12:30 p.m. The walk will be an easy one to two miles, lasting an hour and a half, and is open to adults and children eight years and older.

Participants are advised to bring a hat, gloves, water, snacks, snow boots, sunglasses, and dress in layers. The Forest Service will provide snowshoes. "There are still plenty of openings for those who wish to try out a new winter activity," commented Barbara Jackson, snowshoe program coordinator.
