Antelope Lake Recreation Area

Elevation 5000

Antelope Lake is one of the more remote quiet lakes on the forest. Located 30 miles NE of Taylorsville on the Genesee-Antelope Lake Road, or from Janesville take County road 208 for 4 miles, FS road 28N01 for 9 miles, turn right on FS road 28N03 for 2 miles.

Supplies including groceries, ice, bait, and souvenirs are available from Memorial Day - Labor Day.

Dump Station located near the Boulder Creek Fire Station.

Boulder Creek Campground

- 70 units
- reservations/ first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Lone Rock Campground

- 86 units

Long Point Campground

- 38 units

Bucks Lake Recreation Area

Elevation 5000-5400

Located 32 miles northeast of Oroville on Oroville-Bucks Lake Road. Or 17 miles west of Quincy on Oroville-Bucks Lake Road. Bucks Lake is a high mountain lake surrounded by the Bucks Lake Wilderness on one side and recreation residences/ resorts on the other side. **Supplies** and **boat rentals** are available at resorts.

Whitehorse Campground

- 20 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Sundew Campground

- 19 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 - \$18 site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Mill Creek Campground

- 10 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 - \$18 site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Lower Bucks Campground/ Day Use Area

- 6 units - first come-first serve
- \$12 site fee
- No water/ limited sanitation facilities at day use area.

Grizzly Creek Campground

- 8 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Hutchins Group Campground

- 3 units
- Reservations Only
- \$45 site fee (25 people per site)
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Feather River Canyon Area

Elevation 2300 - 2600

Located 32 miles west of Quincy on Hwy 70, Gansner Bar, North Fork and Queen Lily are located on the west branch of the N.F. of the Feather River along Caribou Road. Hallstead is located along the Feather River on Hwy 70 just 17 miles west of Quincy. Supples are available in Belden, Twain, and Quincy.

Gansner Bar Campground

- 14 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

North Fork Campground

- 20 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Queen Lily Campground

- 12 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Hallstead Campground

Located 17 miles west of Quincy on Hwy 70, near Twain.

- 20 units - reservations/ first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tent/ trailer

Spanish Creek Campground

Off Hwy. 70, 8 miles west of Quincy. Supplies available in Quincy. Open Memorial Day - Labor Day.

- Elev. 3,200
- 20 units - first come-first serve
- \$16 single site fee
- Water, vault toilets, tent/trailer
- Estimated open date/ May 1, 2004
- Free DAY USE area

"Non Fee" Campgrounds

The following **5** campgrounds are **"Self Service"** **No fees** are charged. All have **Vault Toilets**. There is **no piped water**. Trailer space is available with the exception of Silver Lake Campground.

Deanes Valley Campground

4 miles SW of Quincy. Off Bucks Lake Rd take the Slate Ck/ Deanes Valley Rd

- Elev. 4,400
- 7 units - first come-first serve

Silver Lake Campground

Off Bucks Lake Rd, 16 miles west of Quincy.

- Elev. 5,800
- 8 units - first come-first serve

Snake Lake Campground

Off Bucks Lake Rd., eight miles northwest of Quincy.

- Elev. 5,800
- 7 units - first come-first serve

Brady's Camp Campground

Off Hwy. 70, 6 miles east of Quincy. Take Squirrel Creek turnoff, go 8 miles toward Argentine Lookout.

- Elev. 7,200
- 4 units - first come-first serve
