Note:

Open water sources are easily contaminated by human or animal waste. Water from springs, lakes, ponds, and streams should be properly treated before drinking. One recommended method of treatment is to bring clear water to a rolling boil for five minutes.

Trail Description

Take a short stroll through the forest to these impressive rock formations. Big Bald Rock offers spectacular views overlooking Oroville Lake and the Sacramento Valley. The trail is an easy walk with a scramble over rocks near the top. Children of all ages will have fun searching for the "snail-rock" or sitting inside the shelter, complete with a stove. If you are a night owl, come sit in the light of the full moon or count the stars in the wane of the moon.

(The trail is generally open for hiking from February to December, snow and road conditions permitting.)
