

Application for a Wilderness Permit

Trinity Alps Wilderness
Weaverville & Big Bar Stations • Shasta-Trinity National Forest



PERMIT REQUIRED...

A wilderness Visitor's Permit is required to enter the Trinity Alps Wilderness. It is free to anyone who will follow simple rules intended to protect both the visitor and the wilderness resource. This permit is only valid for the Trinity Alps Wilderness and is not valid in any other wilderness area.

A CAMPFIRE PERMIT IS REQUIRED if you plan on having a campfire, or using a portable stove between May 1 and October. Please include your drivers license number or Identification card number.

YOUR PERMIT IS GOOD FOR A SINGLE TRIP...

A separate permit is required for each trip. A group staying together needs only one permit. Currently, group size is limited to no more than 10 persons. Specific areas may be subject to additional restrictions on group size. A special permit is required for larger groups.

HOW TO OBTAIN YOUR PERMIT...

Wilderness permits can be obtained at the Forest Service offices listed below. To obtain your permit by mail, complete this application and mail it to the office closest to your planned entry point. (See addresses below and map on back). Your permit will be mailed back to you within 1 - 2 weeks. In some cases you may make arrangements by phone, including after hours pickup.
