2004 Kids' Fishing Day at Jubilee Lake



July 24, 2004-More than 100 kids signed up to participate in the annual Jubilee Lake Kids Fishing Day on the Umatilla National Forest. Over 70 parents, grandparents and adult friends participated as well.

Participants came from 14 local communities, including Walla Walla and College Place, Kennewick and Pasco, Umatilla, LaGrande, Hermiston, Milton-Freewater and Pendleton.

Smaller communities represented included Athena, Weston, Imbler, Adams and Lexington.

ODFW stocked the lake just prior to the event to ensure plenty of rainbow trout would be available for kids to catch. Jubilee is a high-elevation lake offering hot-weather fishing opportunities at cooler elevations.

Jubilee Kids Fishing Day provides a great opportunity for parents and grandparents to enjoy the outdoors with their children and grandchildren.
