Summary of Conversation: Mr. Cloud had received the Toolbox scoping. His initial concern, and the one he spoke to the most dealt with the unfairness of law enforcement regarding personal use fuelwood cutting. This centered on an incident during the past weekend here a friend of his received a \$60 ticket for not having his tickets attached to his load (he instead apparently simply had them with him in the vehicle.) Though this doesn't directly relate to Toolbox, it was cited as an example of the heavy-handed treatment that the Forest Service has toward the public, something Bill is very troubled about. The direct tie to Toolbox would be in regard to proposed road closures. In previous conversations with Mr. Cloud, as well as the 11/19 phone call, he has strongly objected to the closing of public roads on public lands as a matter of principle and as an example of loss of freedom at the hands of the Federal Government.

Follow-up Needed: Consider the loss of public access to public lands, due to road management, as a possible issue during the planning process for the Toolbox Fire Recovery project.
