Cassidy Bridge Primitive Camp

Highlights

This primitive hunt camp is located in a nicely wooded area along the banks of the Chauga River. The Chauga is one of the popular fishing streams on the district.

During big-game and turkey hunting seasons, the campground is opened for hunters. During the rest of the year, the camp is available for group reservations 2 weeks or more in advance. Families like to reserve the camp for reunions, cookouts, and camp outs.

Surrounding Area

Brasstown Falls is about 25 minutes from this hunt camp. Check with the ranger station for specific directions. The Chattooga River and commercial river outfitters are within 15 minutes.

Directions: From the Andrew Pickens District Office drive 1/8 mile north. Turn left onto Whetstone Road. Turn left onto Cassidy bridge road and follow it all the way to Cassidy Bridge Hunt Camp on the left.

Facilities: Pit toilet

Fee: Reservation fee (\$30) if reserved, otherwise area is free during big-game and turkey hunting seasons.

Restrictions: 14-day stay limit

Safety: Watch out for usual dangers such as poisonous snakes and stinging insects.

Season: Opened during big game hunting season (October 1--December 31) and turkey season (April 1--30) and by reservation for a \$30 fee per night during the rest of the year.
