Long Cane Seasonal Camps

Highlights

Three seasonal camps offer primitive facilities in the east central and northern portions of the Long Cane Ranger District of the Sumter National Forest

All three camps offer a rustic setting ideal for hunting. The surrounding forest environment sustains abundant wildlife populations, resulting in some of the most desirable hunting areas in the upstate. Deer, turkey, and quail are managed as well as non-game species. Several check stations and supply stores are in the vicinity.

Cyper Creek Campground—Directions: From McCormick, take US Route 378 east for 9.9 miles. Turn right onto Route S 19/423 (Gilcrest Road) and drive 2.4 miles. Turn left onto Route S 19/295 and drive 1.2 miles to entrance on right.

Midway Camp—Directions: From Abbeville, take SC Highway 72 east for 6.1 miles to Beulah Church. Turn right on gravel road (FS Road 506 for 0.6 mile to entrance on left.

Morrow Bridge Camp—Directions: From McCormick, take SC Route 28 north for 13.8 miles. Turn left onto Route S 33-37 and drive 0.4 mile. Turn left onto Route S 33-39 and drive 0.6 mile to entrance on left.

From Abbeville, take SC Route 28 south for 11.7 miles. Make a sharp right turn onto Route S 33-37 and drive 0.4 mile. Turn left onto Route S 33-39 and drive 0.6 mile to entrance on left.

All Long Cane seasonal camps:

Fees: \$5/night, \$50/month, \$150/season. (Self-service fee station available.)

Facilities:

- *Central water source
- *Pit Toilets

Requirements: South Carolina hunting regulations apply. Off-highway vehicles (OHVs) are allowed only on designated OHV trails.

Reservations: Sites are first come first served for nightly camping. Reservations are needed for monthly and seasonal camping. Seasonal reservations may be made starting January 2 for the same year.

Safety: Hunting is not permitted within 300 yards of camps.

Season: September 15–December 31.
