**Directions:** From I-26, take exit 60 (SC 66) southwest for 3.5 miles. Turn right onto FS Road 358 and drive 0.3 mile.

From Whitmire take SC Route 66 southwest for 6.2 miles to Forest Service Road 358; turn left (south) and drive for 0.3 mile.

**Drinking water:** centrally-located water faucets, **CAUTION—well is going dry.**

**Please do not hook any hoses or run water continuously for long periods. Doing so will deplete the water reserve in the well and will take 1 to 2 hours to recharge.**

#### Facilities:

- \* 23 campsites with tables, grills, and lantern holders
- \* Restrooms

**Fees:** \$5/night, first come, first served.

**Safety:** Care should be taken in the woods during big-game season. Wear blaze orange.

**Season:** year-round

**Regulations:** South Carolina fishing and hunting license and regulations apply on all National Forest land. Horses are allowed in designated area only.

**Restrictions:** 14 day stay limit
