### **Greendale Project Record of Decision Green Mountain National Forest Manchester Ranger District Manchester Center, Vermont**

On February 2, 2004, District Ranger Gina Owens, Manchester Ranger District, Green Mountain National Forest made a decision to select Alternative IV-Modified Proposed Action as the course of action for the Greendale Project. This decision is documented in the Greendale Project Record of Decision, released along with the Greendale Project Final Environmental Impact Statement.

Alternative IV calls for harvesting timber and improving wildlife habitat on 796 acres, treating 44 acres of historic apple orchards, and improving stream and fisheries habitat on Jenny Coolidge Brook. These activities will occur in the town of Weston, Windsor County, Vermont. This decision is subject to appeal pursuant to 36 CFR 215.7. To appeal this decision, a written Notice of Appeal must be postmarked or received within 45 calendar days after the date that this legal notice of decision is published in the Rutland Herald newspaper, Rutland, VT. The first day of the filing period begins on the day after the legal notice appears in the aforementioned paper of record.
