

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT “ERRATA SHEET”

Mount Tabor Seasonal Housing Facilities
Green Mountain National Forest, Manchester Ranger District
Town of Mount Tabor – Rutland County, VT

- Page 2-3 (Section 2.2.5, sentence 3): Replace sentence with “Parking for snowmobile activities at the Mount Tabor Work Center administrative site will continue as it currently exists, but will be phased out as soon as the new housing facilities are operational during the winter months and/or snowmobile parking becomes incompatible with the administrative functions of the facilities.”
- Page 2-9, Table 2.2 (Alternative 4, item a under *Socioeconomics* Effect/Indicator): Change “5/0” to “5/20”.
- Page 3-7 (Section 3.1.2.2, Municipal Services, *Water*, third paragraph, last sentence): Replace with “This would replace the need to connect to the Danby/Mount Tabor water system entirely.”
- Page 3-7 (Section 3.1.2.2, Municipal Services, *Schools*, sentence 1): Replace the first part of the sentence with “Since it would be GMNF policy not to allow children to stay at the Mount Tabor seasonal housing facilities beyond periodic visits,…”.
- Page 3-11 (Section 3.1.2.4, Municipal Services, *Water*, third paragraph, last sentence): Replace with “This would replace the need to connect to the Danby/Mount Tabor water system entirely.”
- Page 3-32 (Section 3.7.2, TES Plants, last sentence): Replace with “This effect would be minimal since most of the disturbed ground that could be invaded by these plants would be utilized by buildings or parking. Mechanical and other control of non-native invasive plant species known to occur within the project area would help ensure they would be prevented from spreading onto disturbed ground resulting from construction activities (Mitigation Measures SP-1 and SP-2, Appendix B).”
- Page 3-40 (Income Demographics for the Green Mountain National Forest Region Table): Change “Table 3.4” to “Table 3.5”.
- Page 4-1 (Section 4.1): Change “Kim Kimville” to “Kim Kinville”.
- Page B-1 (Socioeconomics, S-1): Replace sentence with “Children will not be allowed to stay at the Mount Tabor seasonal housing facilities beyond periodic visits to official residents of the site.”
- Page B-1 (Socioeconomics): Change S-1 to read “Develop on-site domestic water sources (well or spring) to replace the need to connect to the Danby/Mount Tabor water system entirely.”
- Page B-1 (Socioeconomics): Add “S-7: If excessive traffic speed along the work center access road (FR48) becomes a safety issue after it is widened/paved, selected traffic calming measures will be implemented accordingly (i.e., increased law enforcement, additional signing, speed bumps, etc.)”.
- Page B-2: Add “Sensitive Plants (To prevent the spread of non-native invasive plant species known to occur within the project area onto disturbed ground resulting from construction activities)
 - SP-1: Disturbed sites not occupied by building construction or pavement will be reseeded with a native seed mix.
 - SP-2: Any individual plants of morrow honeysuckle (*Lonicera morrowi*) will be cut back to the ground. Any individual plants of purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*) will be pulled prior to seed. Repeat both treatments as needed during construction activities and, if applicable, several years after construction activities are complete.
