Last August you received a letter from us inviting you to participate in the process of revising our Land and Resource Management Plan (Forest Plan).

The Ottawa's Forest Plan is a strategic document that outlines broad goals and priorities for the Forest for a 10-15 year period. It is the guiding document for how your National Forest is managed. Our existing Plan was approved in 1986 and has been updated periodically through the amendment process. Through the revision process we will review the Plan and determine if any additional changes are needed.
