



- | MANAGEMENT AREA # | DESIRED CONDITION OF THE LAND |
|-------------------|--|
| 2.1 | Predominantly large-diameter hardwood forests adjoining fishing-canoing streams; primarily uneven-aged timber management; roaded natural recreation. |
| 2.2 | Uneven-aged timber management; roaded natural nonmotorized recreation. |
| 3.1 | Even-aged timber management; hardwood rotation of 80 years and conifer rotation of 60 years; roaded natural recreation. |
| 3.2 | Same as 3.1, except high density off-road vehicle use on designated trails; recreation use primarily ORV use. |
| 3.3 | Even-aged timber management; hardwood and conifer rotation of 120 years; roaded natural nonmotorized recreation. |
| 6.1 | Similar to 3.3, except public access is walk-in only; semiprimitive nonmotorized recreation. |
| 6.2 | Natural forest; no timber harvest or wildlife habitat improvements; semiprimitive, nonmotorized recreation. |
| 9.1 | Small, isolated tracts of National Forest available for exchange. |
| 9.2 | Potential 8.1 and 8.2 areas which are being investigated for designation. |




