Management Area #	Acres Offered	Desired Condition of the Land
2.1	0	Predominantly large-diameter hardwood forests adjoining fishing-canoeing streams; primarily uneven-aged timber management; roaded natural recreation.
2.2	165.56	Uneven-aged timber management; roaded natural nonmotorized recreation.
2.3	260.71	Same as 2.2 except low-density off-road vehicle use on designated trails; roaded natural recreation.
3.1	838.01	Even-aged timber management; hardwood rotation of 80 years and conifer rotation of 60 years; roaded natural recreation.
3.2	251.65	Same as 3.1, except high density off-road vehicle use on designated trails; recreation use primarily ORV use .
3.3	2,305.86	Even-aged timber management; hardwood and conifer rotation of 120 years; roaded natural nonmotorized recreation.
6.1	323.30	Same as 3.3 except public access is walk-in only; semiprimitive nonmotorized recreation.
6.2	238.13	Natural forest; no timber harvest or wildlife habitat improvements; semiprimitive, nonmotorized recreation.
7.1	0	Developed recreation areas.
8.1	0	Research natural areas with no manipulation of vegetation.

8.2	0	Special areas.
9.2	200	Potential 8.1 and 8.2 areas which are being investigated for designation.
