To offer 4,634 acres of National Forest lands for oil and gas leasing with standard surface protection stipulations, the application of Best Management Practices and & the 2001 Biological Opinion Terms & Conditions.		
<b>Management Area #</b>	<b>Acres Offered</b>	<b>Desired Condition of the Land</b>
<b>2.1</b>	<b>0</b>	Predominantly large-diameter hardwood forests adjoining fishing-canoeing streams; primarily uneven-aged timber management; roaded natural recreation.
<b>2.2</b>	<b>165.56</b>	Uneven-aged timber management; roaded natural nonmotorized recreation.
<b>2.3</b>	<b>260.71</b>	Same as 2.2 except low-density off-road vehicle use on designated trails; roaded natural recreation.
<b>3.1</b>	<b>838.01</b>	Even-aged timber management; hardwood rotation of 80 years and conifer rotation of 60 years; roaded natural recreation.
<b>3.2</b>	<b>251.65</b>	Same as 3.1, except high density off-road vehicle use on designated trails; recreation use primarily ORV use .
<b>3.3</b>	<b>2,305.86</b>	Even-aged timber management; hardwood and conifer rotation of 120 years; roaded natural nonmotorized recreation.
<b>6.1</b>	<b>323.30</b>	Same as 3.3 except public access is walk-in only; semiprimitive nonmotorized recreation.
<b>6.2</b>	<b>238.13</b>	Natural forest; no timber harvest or wildlife habitat improvements; semiprimitive, nonmotorized recreation.
<b>7.1</b>	<b>0</b>	Developed recreation areas.
<b>8.1</b>	<b>0</b>	Research natural areas with no manipulation of vegetation.

<b>8.2</b>	<b>0</b>	Special areas.
<b>9.2</b>	<b>200</b>	Potential 8.1 and 8.2 areas which are being investigated for designation.
