3	48.62	Special Natural Area with Management Area 6.2
4	10.63	Special Natural Area with Management Area 6.2
10	80	Tract contains two stands that are estimated to be 123 years old (potential old growth, DEIS E-16). These stands cover eastern half of tract. The eastern half of the tract has deep ravine habitat and steep sideslopes. Remainder of tract has deep ravine habitat and steep sideslopes, making access available only from adjacent lands.
16	64.66	The tract is found on steep sideslopes (>55%) and in a deep ravine/creek channel.
19	85.94	Sensitive riparian
23	50.31	Sensitive Floodplain
38	70.43	Wetland habitat
39	400	Special Area, steep slopes and lack of access
42	3.2	The small tract is found on sideslopes and in a creek channel. There is concern about how a well or access facilities could be placed on the tract without accessing the tract from adjacent lands.
45	178.88	Natural Area, Vesuvius recreation
51	27.57	Caulley Creek Special Area and tract is found on steep sideslopes and in a deep ravine/creek channel. The NSO stipulation for riparian and NSO for slopes >55% removes a portion of this tract already. There is concern about how a well or access facilities could be placed on the tract without accessing the tract from adjacent lands.
52	21.52	Highly sensitive wildlife resources
