

Attachment C-4 Sample Description of the Inventory Data Base Structure

The inventory provided to the Contractor in Phases 1 through 3 of the NRRS™, shown in Section C, Table C-2, will be provided in a uniform data base structure (see Section C, paragraph 4.3.3). Table C-4-1 below contains a sample description of this uniform data base structure, including the data field name, type, width, and definition. The actual data base structure, including several data fields and data field types, widths, and definitions, will change. Several data fields will also be deleted and new data fields added. The inventory data base may be provided in several relational data bases.
